## INTEREST-BASED BARGAINING CERTIFICATION PROCESS

In addition to attending 4 virtual live sessions, participants receive access to a private learning management system for 12 months, which includes the following:

- 3 on-demand modules
- Full suite of tools and facilitator guides for use
- Collaborative space for sharing tools and resources

Once the first 4 sessions of training have been completed, participants receive a *Verification of Completion* and are ready to engage in a co-facilitation practicum. Following the practicum completion, facilitators are awarded their *Certification*.
